The last book of the New Testament is REVELATION!!

This is referred to as *Apocalyptic* writing (unveiling of future events).

Revelation has been interpreted in a variety of ways over the centuries, but the central purpose of the book is to encourage Christians in every age to maintain their faith despite opposition, and to do so in the confidence that they will share in Jesus' ultimate victory over all forces that oppose Jesus and His people.

Revelation consist of a series of scenes ending with the triumph of God.
